

i>clicker Student Guide

If you are reading this guide, then most likely your instructor has chosen to incorporate the use of the i>clicker response tool into a course that you are taking.

You have your remote – now you'll need to know how to use it, and how to set it up to register your name next to your responses.

Important Note: Keep your receipt for your i>clicker remote!

If, at any point during the semester, your clicker is not functioning properly, bring it back to the bookstore for a replacement.

Registering your i>clicker Remote

Register your clicker as soon as you get the remote! You will receive no credit for your participation until you have properly registered your device with your UMS Student ID.

Follow these steps carefully to be sure it registers properly.

1. Go to <http://www.iclicker.com/registration/> and enter in your First and Last name.
2. Next enter in your UMS Student ID - the unique seven digit number that is your identification on campus. You can find this number by logging into MaineStreet (<https://peportal.maine.edu/>) and navigating to your Student Center. Your UMS Student ID will appear in the upper right – underneath the link to log out of MaineStreet.
3. Next, enter in the unique radio ID from your remote itself. This is the **alphanumeric code on the back of your remote, underneath the barcode**. Check it twice to be sure you've entered it correctly.
4. Now retype the verification word and hit the 'ENTER' button.
5. **You're not finished yet, though! The next step is crucial.**
6. On the final screen you'll be asked to review your data before you submit it.

IMPORTANT – REMEMBER THESE STEPS:

- Register your i>clicker remote as soon as you get it.
- Remember to hit 'SUBMIT' on the second page when registering.
- Keep your receipt for the whole semester.

The i>clicker Remote

This is an i>clicker remote – yours should look identical to this. The use of this device could hardly be simpler:

First, when you take your remote out of the packaging, pull the tab on the back coming out of the battery compartment – this will get the battery power flowing.

Bring your remote to every class – at some point in class, your instructor will tell you to turn your clickers on and be ready to answer questions. Press the **ON/OFF** button. The power light will turn blue (The clicker will power itself off after a few minutes of inactivity)

Below the power light are two more LED indicators – Low Battery and Vote Status.

The Low Battery light will pulse red when you need to change the batteries – change them as soon as the light starts blinking (the back of the remote states you have ten hours of life left, but our tests have found that to be untrue – the device will not function properly without a new set of batteries).

The Vote Status Light indicates whether or not your answer was successfully received – a green light means that your answer was successfully registered, a red light means that it was not.

The five lettered keys along the face choose your answer – just hit the key for the answer you want. The Vote Status light will blink green.
