

## MEE New Faculty Ad

The University of Maine, Department of Mechanical Engineering invites applications for a tenure track faculty position. The successful candidate for the position will be expected to be highly motivated in research with a background in one of the traditional areas of mechanical engineering. A preference will be given to candidates with an emphasis on biomedical applications and research. The successful candidate is expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in traditional areas of mechanical engineering such as fluids, design, solids and thermal sciences. An ability to teach biomedical engineering courses such as introductory biomedical engineering is also desirable. Candidates with a PH.D degree or equivalent in mechanical engineering or related fields with teaching experience at the undergraduate and graduate levels are encouraged to apply. Interested parties should submit a cover letter, a statement of teaching interests, a plan for developing his/her research programs and names, addresses, email address and phone numbers of at least three references as well as a complete curriculum vita.
