

AATF – Maine encourages teachers to apply for the \$250 Richard Williamson Scholarship for Teachers (2012) to attend a workshop or seminar during the summer for professional growth.

Purpose:

The scholarship encourages French teachers to participate in a seminar or Conference which will further their education and make them better teachers of French.

Eligibility:

- a) Need to be an active member of the Maine Chapter of AATF.
- b) Send a brief resume in English (1 page or less) including where you teach, for how long, what your goals are, and how we can reach you. Also state program costs and how you are funding your attendance at the workshop/conference.
- c) Write a brief letter in French (1 page or less) explaining why you want to attend the workshop/conference and what you hope to gain from the experience.
- d) Report on your experience at the Fall AATF Conference.

Deadlines and where to send application:

- a) Application are due by Friday, May 11, 2012. Decisions will be made by the AATF – Maine Board by May 25, 2012.
