In order to insure the orderly flow of traffic, maximum utilization of parking facilities and access to buildings for emergency vehicles, it is necessary to establish and enforce rules governing vehicle operation and parking on campus. The policies governing parking apply to **everyone** utilizing roadways and parking lots at the University of Maine. Below is a brief overview of the Faculty/Staff Parking Rules and Regulations.

Parking is permitted:

- in "Blue" Faculty/Staff designated lots.
- in "Black" Commuter designated lots.

Parking is not permitted:

- in fire-lane, handicap, loading-zone, service-vehicle, or reserved areas (except when authorized); vehicles in violation will be cited and towed at the owner's expense.
- in "Red" Resident designated lots.
- for "Visitor Only" designated parking.
- for "Cutler Patient Parking" (without the proper permit).
- any where that obstructs the flow of traffic in a driveway or roadway.
- for parking on unpaved or turf areas.
- for parking on sidewalks, in crosswalks, in striped areas, or in front of dumpsters.

Between November 1 and May 1 the faculty/staff, commuter and visitor lots are closed to parking between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 AM. The Hilltop (commuter section only) and College Ave. So. lots are available for temporary parking during these hours.

No-charge visitor and temporary permits may be obtained at the Student Service Center, Bear Necessities (Alfond Arena), Visitor's Center (Buchanan/Alumni House) during Monday-Friday business hours (8 AM – 4:30 PM) or at Public Safety (Rangeley Rd) open 24/7.
