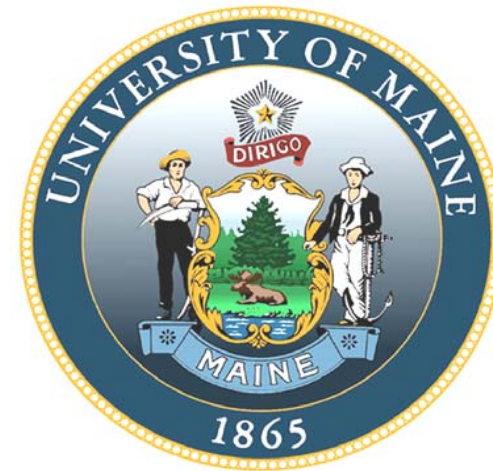

Service award recipients include individuals who have achieved 25, 35, or 45 years of continuous regular service measured since the last recognition program through August 31, 2009.

The employees recognized by this program have demonstrated a high level of service and dedication to the University. Award recipients attending the banquet will be individually honored by featured speakers from our University leadership including Vice President for Administration and Finance Janet Waldron. Each award recipient will receive two complimentary tickets for the banquet. Additional tickets for family, friends and co-workers may be purchased for \$22 each.

A statement gathered from the employee's supervisor and/or colleagues will be read aloud and a picture will be taken of the employee receiving a certificate of appreciation. Each Outstanding Employee Award recipient will receive \$1,000 added to their May paycheck, a commemorative plaque, lapel pin or medal, and a certificate. IRS regulations require that the monetary award be taxed as earnings.

To be considered eligible for recognition, the employee must be at least 55 years of age and have a minimum of 10 years of continuous regular service.

Retirees attending the banquet will be individually honored by featured speakers from our University leadership including Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost Susan Hunter. Harold 'Brownie' Brown, 4-H Specialist and Extension Professor Emeritus, Chair of the President's Council of Retired Employees, will again serve as Master of Ceremonies.
