ABSTRACT: Marylou Murphy and Paul Correia from Unum will discuss career opportunities in the actuarial profession. Marylou will describe the role actuaries play and the skill sets needed to excel. In addition, she will discuss opportunities at Unum, a leading provider of employee benefits and the market leader in providing disability and long term care insurance in the U.S.

Paul Correia will then describe his experiences to date in the career path and how his educational background has helped him succeed.

*Marylou Murphy received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mathematics from Worcester Polytechnic Institute in 1987. She began her career at The Paul Revere Insurance Company in Worcester, MA as part of their Actuarial Development Program, working primarily on Disability and Life Insurance Pricing and Valuation. In 1998, she relocated to Portland ME and joined Unum as a Long Term Care Actuary. In her current role as VP of Performance Management & Metrics at Unum, she leads a team of Actuarial and Financial professionals who focus on business and financial analysis.

**Paul Correia received a Bachelor's degree from the University of Vermont in 1994 and a Masters Degree in Mathematics from the University of Maine in 2001. In graduate school, Paul studied applications of the Mittag-Leffler theorem in connection to the Riemann Zeta function. Paul began his Actuarial career at Unum in 2006 and is currently working in group valuation.
