

## U.S. National Unused and Expired Medicines Registry

This is currently under development and the attached reporting form is a voluntary form for the development of a registry. This registry is intended as a focal point for efforts to remove excess medications from medicine cabinets across the US. It is anticipated that this will result in fewer childhood overdoses, less abuse and misuse in other age groups and limit environmental impact. Data collected will help policy makers regarding pharmacy policy, patient education and safety, and prescribing options.
