The Maine Business School has developed a five-year MBA program for undergraduate students in non-business disciplines. To ensure consistency in communication and to meet student and faculty expectations, the business school asks interested academic units to agree to the following.

Inform students about the five-year MBA program. In particular, first year students should be aware so they may plot an appropriate course of study to meet certain undergraduate course and grade hurdles.

Provide information to academic advisors so they may advise students about an appropriate course of study leading to successful entry into the five-year MBA.

Allow the business school to periodically present information to students in classes or in other established forums.

Request that each student interested in the five year MBA program fill out a simple, one-page “declaration of interest” form.

Provide information about the five-year MBA on the unit’s website or link directly to the Maine Business School MBA page.

The Maine Business School graduate program office agrees to:

Be available to students and faculty to provide information and answer questions, individually or in groups.

Keep track of all students who have declared the “declaration of interest” and to periodically communicate with them and their advisors about any changes to the Maine Business School MBA program or the Five-Year plan.

Post information about the five-year MBA on the MBA website, and keep it accurately updated.

Both units agree to work collaboratively to develop a program of study that satisfies both partners' academic requirements. This will be included with this agreement.
