

## PEER MEDIATION AND SCHOOL CLIMATE ASSESSMENT

—Survey Packet Information—

Each school will receive one copy of its report within approximately 30 days from the receipt of the data at the center. In the case of the Peer Mediator Questionnaires, the report will be generated after the receipt of the post program survey.

**Peer Mediator Questionnaires** (available for the following grade spans: Grades 4-6 and Grades 6-12)  
\$250 for initial packet and \$2 per additional survey set (pre and post)

- Surveys will be packaged in groups of 15 and will include 15 pre and 15 post surveys.
- One report which includes a comparison for pre and post data will be produced for each school that **returns both pre and post surveys**.
- The report will include tables of frequencies and a brief summary of the results. Further interpretation of the data will be the responsibility of the school.

**Peer Mediation Exit Survey** (available for the following grade spans: Grades K-6 and Grades 6-12)  
\$250 for initial packet and \$1 per additional survey.

- Students who take part in mediation complete this survey.
- Surveys will be packaged in groups of 25.
- Surveys can be administered throughout the school year but should be sent to the University all together near the end of the school year.
- A report will include tables of frequencies and a brief summary of the results. Further interpretation of the data will be the responsibility of the school.

**School Climate Surveys** (available for the following grade spans: Grades K-6 and Grades 6-12)  
The school pays the cost of printing the surveys. The Center will scan the surveys, analyze the data and report the results for a cost of \$350.

- This survey provides a snapshot of climate issues related to conflict.
- The report will consist of tables of frequencies. The interpretation of the data will be the responsibility of the school.
